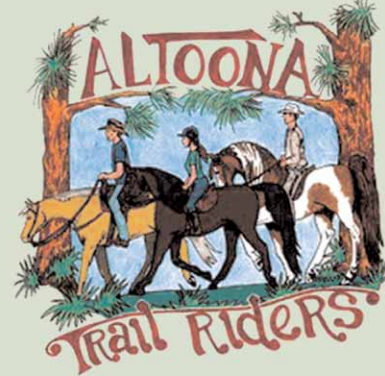
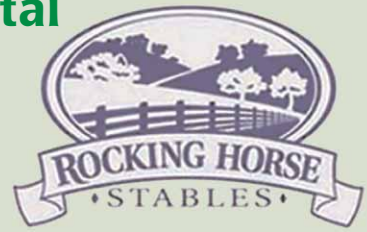


Spring Trail Ride 2004 to benefit Shands Children's Hospital

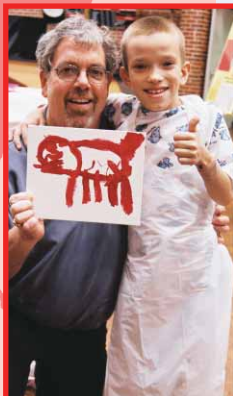
