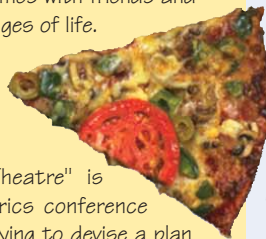

SHANDS SAFE KIDS RECEIVES NATIONAL AWARD

National SAFE KIDS Campaign Recognizes Coalition for Outstanding Web site

Shands Safe Kids was honored by the National SAFE KIDS Campaign with the Outstanding Web site Award at the Campaign's 15th Annual Leadership Conference held in Washington, D.C. Shands Safe Kids received the award from Campaign Executive Director Heather Paul and received a standing ovation from Campaign staff, proud sponsors, fellow coalition coordinators and members and friends of SAFE KIDS.

The Web site, shandssafekids.org, includes information about safety events including car seat checks and classes, meetings and safety fairs. The interactive Web site even allows parents to register for upcoming car seat checks online and sign up for the Safe Kids Club.

"Shands Safe Kids should be very proud of the work they have accomplished over the past year," said Heather Paul, Ph.D., executive director of the national SAFE KIDS Campaign. "We are very proud to award them with the Outstanding Web site Award and look forward to their continued success in preventing injuries and saving lives."

"We are very excited about this national award. It reflects the hardwork of all of our coalition members who are doing their part to advocate for change and prevent unintentional injury to children" said Mindy Underberger, Shands Safe Kids Coordinator.

Shands Safe Kids is a part of the National Safe Kids Campaign, the first and only national nonprofit organization dedicated solely to the prevention of unintentional childhood injury - the number one killer of children ages 14 and under. Shands Safe Kids is led by Shands Children's Hospital at the University of Florida and is composed of public, private and voluntary organizations, as well as individuals. Locally, Safe Kids is funded in large part by the Children's Miracle Network.
