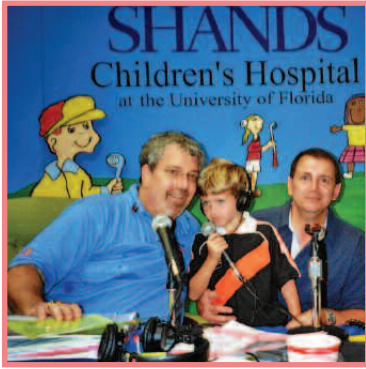


2005 Miracle Maker's Radiothon celebrates five years and \$1 million in pledges for Children's Miracle Network
