• Legislative Session Blues and BBQ in Tallahassee

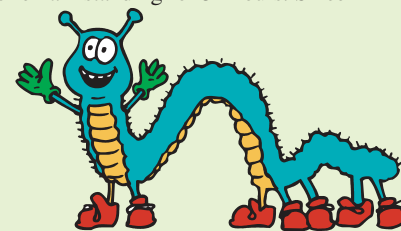
March 27
